

Three-year Health Guarantee

For Hips, Heart and Eyes

for Puppies In Paradise

This is a guarantee that your new puppy appears free of health issues (unless otherwise noted on the veterinary report). At the age of 5-7 weeks, this puppy was examined by a veterinarian, and unless otherwise noted on the report, appears normal & healthy. If you accept your puppy with the veterinary report that is given to you for the puppy that you picked out and accepted, you take all responsibility for the puppy and all vet bills that may accrue in the future if it is not covered in this health guarantee. This health guarantee covers hips, heart, and eyes and is good from the day your puppy was born till three years of age. After three years, this health guarantee is void.

Every puppy must see a licensed veterinarian within 10 days from leaving Puppies In Paradise or the health guarantee is void.

Listed here are a few examples that do not apply and are not covered within this health guarantee, are as follows but not limited to; Crypt orchids, (left, right or both). Any skin infection like lice or mange that may occur after your puppy leaves Puppies In Paradise. Fleas or parasites of any kind. (internal or external). Small Umbilical Hernia not requiring surgery. Any diseases the puppy might pick up after leaving Puppies In Paradise.

You must vaccinate your puppy with the appropriate vaccines at the appropriate time and age of the puppy.

Please know that all puppies can have worms or internal parasites. We deworm regularly and to the best of our knowledge, your puppy has no parasite issue. However, if your puppy has any parasites this does not mean that your puppy is un-healthy... it just means that you must keep up the treatments that your veterinarian gives the puppy or recommends.

If your puppy develops a poor level, past fair, of hip dysplasia, you must prove this hereditary and not caused from being overweight or an injury of any kind. Your puppy must be examined by a licensed veterinarian & the weight of the puppy must be listed on the report along with the age and date of the exam. You must have an OFA report completed to accompany your veterinarian exam report.

If your puppy is developing cataracts or tests positive for PRA, you must prove this hereditary and not caused from an injury of any kind. You must have a written statement from your licensed veterinarian stating this.

If your puppy has an enlarged heart or heart murmur where it needs to be euthanized, you must have a written statement from your licensed veterinarian stating this.

If your puppy has the before mentioned hip, heart, or eye issues that prove to be hereditary, you have two options. I will either replace your puppy with another puppy of the same breed & gender from the first available litter, or I will refund the veterinarian costs up to the amount paid for the puppy. Any costs over the amount paid for the puppy are to be paid by you, the buyer.

If the puppy is resold to another party other than who I sold the puppy to or at a different residence from where my records indicate the puppy was to go to, this health guarantee is void immediately.

The goal here at Puppies In Paradise is to provide you with a healthy puppy that will stay in your family for years to come. We don't want to see your puppy with a health issue any more than you do. If your puppy shows up with any type of health issue, please contact us so that we are aware of it.
